Another spring has passed and as another fall hunting season draws near it is a busy time of year for us at South Shore Lodge.

We had a late spring this year with high amounts of rain fall; however the bears were very active. We went through amazing amount of bait and feed as there were close to 20 active baits. Our hunters did well, as we have never shot so many bears on the first night. A couple nice color phase bears were taken. All but one hunter was successful in getting a bear; however he saw multiple bears with one even climbing his ladder.

Our summer was cool and wet for the most part causing our grain crops to be about two weeks behind schedule. This should be good news for the fall bird season as there should be plenty of feed for them to stick around. Although it's early in the season there appears to be good numbers of migratory birds in the Lake Winnipegosis area.

Fishing has been absolutely spectacular this summer. In the Mossy you can go and catch your limit of walleye right behind our house. The Waterhen water system and Dauphin Lake have also been great fishing spots this year.

Fall Bear is quickly approaching we are expecting a great season. Baiting is now in full swing with the season beginning at the start of September. Once bear and waterfowl season is complete, the focus will switch to the white tails. There should be some monster bucks around this year! Some big-game tags are still available. Also Sunday big-game hunting has just been approved in our area, so bookings over weekends can now be accepted.
